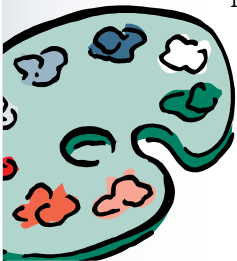

Youth Action Mini-Grants

Youth Action Mini-Grants empower residents to initiate educational projects that will help kids do better in school. Using grass roots fundraising to get started, residents apply for a mini-grant to complete their project or goal. Funds will be distributed under the direction of donors who will match resident fundraising four-to-one. This program gives donors the chance to partner more directly with the residents they are helping and encourages small groups of our

residents, both kids and adults, to create projects that will help kids earn a B average or better in school.



Family Asset Building Program

Community HousingWorks Family Asset Building programs include a wide variety of classes and programs that are specifically designed to help youth and adults become more knowledgeable about money management, budgeting and credit, the power of saving using matched savings accounts, micro enterprise, workforce development and leadership.

All of these programs are available to our residents and nearly all are funded by charitable contributions and private grants.



VALOR Scholarship Program

VALOR scholarships are awarded to enterprising students that live in Community HousingWorks apartments that have demonstrated academic success, volunteerism and leadership abilities. VALOR scholarships are given for college tuition or vocational training. This program, fully funded by charitable contributions, enables many students to be the first in their family to attend higher education.
